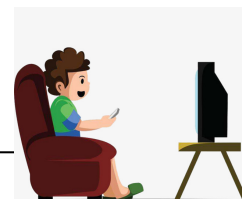

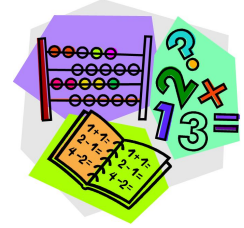

The UAE is home to many beautiful animals, such as camels and cormorants. Animals, such as the Hawksbill turtle, Arabian leopard and the Arabian tahr are all examples of endangered animals. The Arabian tahr is endangered because the places it lives have been used for building homes. For a long time, people have caught and killed Arabian Leopards for money. This has left leopard numbers very low. It can be difficult to find an answer, but the country is working to look after and help endangered species.
