I am directed to enclose a copy of the reference cited and to inform that, the Under Secretary to Government of India, Department of Social Justice and Empowerment has informed that, the Ministry has decided to conduct a physical verification survey of the beneficiaries and institutes covered under Pre and Post matric Scholarship schemes for SC students who have been covered during AY 2022-2023. He has also informed that, the National Council of Applied Economic Research (NCAER) has been entrusted by the Ministry that shall perform the verification study in 13 states. The objective of the study are

- I. To do a physical verification of the institutes and beneficiaries of the scholarship schemes for the year 2022-23 under Centrally Sponsored Schemes of Pre-Matric Scholarships Scheme for SCs and others and Post-Matric Scholarships to SCs for studies in India through verification in order to confirm the payments through DBT in their dedicated Aadhaar seeded Bank accounts and to check the requisite documents of the beneficiaries.

- II. To interact with the Institute Nodal Officer (INO) and District Nodal Officer (DNO) and obtain their observations on the scheme and its implementation
- III. To prepare observations notes for each institute and to give views regarding the efficacy of the scholarship schemes.
