## **CONSTRUCTING YOUR TOWER**

- 1. Print both sheets out on A3 paper, or equivalent size. Cut out each component (1-4) . You don't need to be too exact at this point and should leave maybe half a centimetre of white paper around the outsides.
- 2. Glue the components onto stiff, thin card stock, the stiffer the better this tower will be supporting your miniatures after all! A spray adhesive will work best to avoid bubbling but PVA will work fine too; simply spread it onto the card first and then smooth the paper component gently down in a rolling fashion to remove any air bubbles. Leave your components to dry overnight under some heavy books, or similar.
- 3. Trim the components out, removing any white paper, including from the centre of component 2. A sharp craft knife and steel ruler are best for this job but scissors will work in a pinch.
- 4. Using you knife, or scissors, and a flat edge, score the back of component 4 (that is, the side without your print glued to it) where indicated. Any tabs should be folded away from you as you're looking at the print, so that they will be 'inside' the body of the tower.
- 5. Apply PVA glue to tab A, then fold the tower around until tab A can be pressed firmly inside the tower where indicated. Wait for this to dry and then apply glue to tabs B E and press the tower down firmly in the centre of component 1. Once again, when this has completely dried slot component 2 down over the tower until it fits snuggly. Finally, apply glue to tabs F and G and then press component 3 down firmly on top. Once the glue is dry your tower is ready to play!
